

#### HEALTH AND WELFARE SERVICES AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT dated as of January 4, 2023 by and between the AMITYVILLE UNION FREE SCHOOL DISTRICT (hereinafter referred to as "AMITYVILLE") having its administrative offices at 150 Park Avenue, Amityville, NY 11701, and the WEST ISLIP SCHOOL DISTRICT ("hereinafter referred to as the "SCHOOL DISTRICT RECEIVING SERVICES") having its administrative offices at 100 Sherman Avenue, West Islip, NY 11795

WHEREAS, the school districts who are the parties to this Agreement are duly empowered by Education Law § 912 to enter into a contract for the purpose of providing and/or receiving health and welfare services (collectively, the "Services");

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual covenants and conditions contained in this Agreement, the parties hereby incorporate the above statements into the body of this Agreement as if fully set forth therein and hereby agree as follows:

- 1. DEFINITIONS: For the purposes of this Agreement,
  - a. "SCHOOL DISTRICT PROVIDING SERVICES" or "AMITYVILLE" means the School District in which the nonpublic school requesting the Services is located.
  - b. "SCHOOL DISTRICT RECEIVING SERVICES" means the School District that is contracting for the Services for its resident students who attend a nonpublic school located within the boundaries of the Amityville Union Free School District.
- 2. This Agreement is for the Services provided from September 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023, unless this Agreement is terminated earlier as herein provided.
- 3. If requested by a nonpublic school located within the boundaries of the Amityville Union Free School District, AMITYVILLE will provide health and welfare services to the pupils who attend the nonpublic school equivalent to the health and welfare services that it provides to the public school students enrolled in AMITYVILLE. These requested services will consist of, but not be limited to, the following:
  - a. all services performed by a physician, physician assistant, dentist, dental hygienist, registered professional nurse, nurse practitioner, school psychologist, school social worker or school speech therapist; \*
  - b. dental prophylaxis;
  - c. vision and hearing screening examinations;
  - d. the taking of medical histories and the administration of health screening tests;
  - e. the maintenance of cumulative health records; and
  - f. the administration of emergency care programs for ill or injured students.
  - \* School psychological and speech correction services may be rendered on nonpublic school premises only to the extent that the services are *diagnostic* in nature. To the extent that the services of a school psychologist or school speech language pathologist are therapeutic or remedial in nature, they may be rendered to a student attending a nonpublic school only on a religiously neutral site. A religiously neutral site may be, but is not limited to, a public school, a mobile unit or some other public location.

AMITYVILLE will make its personnel available to the SCHOOL DISTRICT RECEIVING SERVICES for participation in District Child Study, 504 Team and Committee on Special Education meetings, as appropriate. The SCHOOL DISTRICT RECEIVING SERVICES must notify AMITYVILLE of the need for its presence at these meetings within a reasonable time prior to the date of the meeting. Copies of all reports, testing and observation reports prepared in connection with this Agreement will be furnished to the SCHOOL DISTRICT RECEIVING SERVICES upon request.

It is expressly understood and agreed between the parties that: (1) AMITYVILLE may not provide the Services to pupils attending nonpublic schools that are not available to the public school students enrolled in AMITYVILLE's schools; and (2) the services to be provided pursuant to this Agreement will not include any teaching service.

- 4. AMITYVILLE warrants that the Services: (1) will be provided by licensed health and welfare providers; (2) will be performed by healthcare providers that are licensed pursuant to the laws of the State of New York, inclusive of New York State Department of Health and State Education Department Licensing requirements, if applicable; and (3) will be in accord with all pertinent provisions of federal, State, and local statutes, rules and regulations, including Section 912 of the Education Law and the student's Individualized Education Plan ("IEP"), if applicable. AMITYVILLE will certify that all healthcare providers possess documentation evidencing the license qualifications as required by federal, State, or local statutes, rules, regulations and orders.

#### HEALTH AND WELFARE SERVICES AGREEMENT 2022-2023

This Agreement is entered into this	day of	by and between

#### WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, WEST ISLIP School District is authorized pursuant to Section 912 of the Education Law, to enter into a contract with FARMINGDALE for the purpose of having FARMINGDALE provide health and welfare services to children residing in the WEST ISLIP School District and attending a non-public school located in FARMINGDALE,

WHEREAS, certain students who are residents of the WEST ISLIP School District are attending non-public schools located in FARMINGDALE,

WHEREAS, FARMINGDALE has received a request(s) from said non-public schools for the provision of health and welfare services to the aforementioned students,

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained in this Agreement, the parties hereby mutually agree as follows.

- 1. The term of this Agreement shall be from September 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023 inclusive, unless terminated early as provided for in this Agreement.
- 2. FARMINGDALE warrants that the health and welfare services will be provided by licensed health care providers. FARMINGDALE further represents that such services shall be performed by health care providers that are properly licensed under the laws of the State of New York, including New York State Department of Health and the State Education Department licensing requirements, if applicable. FARMINGDALE further represents that such services will be in accordance with all applicable provisions of Federal, State, and local laws, statutes, rules, and regulations, including but not limited to, Section 912 of the Education Law, as well as established policy guidance from the New York State Education Department, and the student's IEP, if applicable. FARMINGDALE shall certify that all service providers possess documentation evidencing such license qualifications as required by Federal, State, and local laws, rules, regulations and orders.
- 3. FARMINGDALE understands and agrees that it will comply and is responsible for complying will all applicable Federal, State, and local laws, rules and regulations with respect to the services provided pursuant to this Agreement.

- 4. The services provided by FARMINGDALE shall be consistent with the services available to students attending public schools within FARMINGDALE; and may include, but are not limited to:
  - a. all services performed by a physician, physician assistant, dentist, dental hygienist, registered professional nurse, nurse practitioner, school psychologist, school social worker, or school speech therapist,
  - b. dental prophylaxis,
  - c. vision and hearing screening examinations,
  - d. the taking of medical histories and the administration of health screening tests.
  - e. the maintenance of cumulative health records, and
  - f. the administration of emergency care programs for ill or injured students.

It is expressly understood and agreed between the parties that the services to be provided pursuant to this Agreement shall not include any teaching services.

- 5. In exchange for the provision of health and welfare services pursuant to this Agreement, WEST ISLIP School District agrees to pay FARMINGDALE the sum of \$1,306.47 per eligible pupil for the 2022–2023 school year.
- 6. WEST ISLIP School District shall pay FARMINGDALE within thirty (30) days of WEST ISLIP School District's receipt of a detailed written invoice from FARMINGDALE. Said invoice shall specify the services provided, dates that the invoice covers, and the total amount due for the period specified.
- 7. If, during the term of this Agreement, a student becomes eligible to receive services pursuant to this Agreement, FARMINGDALE shall undertake to provide services pursuant to this Agreement, and the amount of compensation owed by WEST ISLIP School District shall be prorated accordingly to accurately reflect the period of time services were provided to the student.
- 8. If, during the term of this Agreement, a student ceases to be eligible to receive services pursuant to this Agreement, FARMINGDALE shall no longer be responsible for providing services to that student pursuant to this Agreement, and the amount of compensation owed by WEST ISLIP School District shall be prorated accordingly to accurately reflect the period of time services were provided to the student.
- 9. FARMINGDALE shall furnish any supplies or equipment necessary to provide the services pursuant to this Agreement to the extent such items are not provided by the non-public school.
- 10. Both parties agree to provide the State access to all relevant records which the State requires to determine either WEST ISLIP School District or FARMINGDALE'S compliance with applicable Federal, State, or local laws, rules, or regulations with respect to provision of services pursuant to this Agreement. Both parties agree to retain all materials and records relevant to the execution or performance of their obligations pursuant

to this Agreement in accordance with the record retention requirements for such materials and records.

- 11. Both parties to this Agreement understand that they may receive and/or come into contact with protected health information as defined by the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA) and information protected by the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA). The parties hereby acknowledge their respective responsibilities pursuant to HIPAA and FERPA, to the extent applicable.
- 12. Both parties, their employees, and/or agents agree that all information obtained in connection with the services performed pursuant to this Agreement is deemed confidential information. In addition, both parties agree that information concerning any student covered by the terms of this Agreement shall not be released except as provided for by applicable law, rule, or regulation, including but not limited to the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) and the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA).

FARMINGDALE shall comply with all applicable provisions of the Safe Schools Against Violence in Education (SAVE) Act, including, but not limited to background checks and fingerprinting of all staff directly providing services to students. All persons providing services to students pursuant to this Agreement must receive clearance for employment by the New York State Education Department prior to the provision of such services.
- 14. <u>Termination</u>: This Agreement may only be terminated in accordance with applicable law.

#### 15. <u>Defense / Indemnification:</u>

- FARMINGDALE agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless a) the WEST ISLIP School District, its Board of Education, Board members, officers, directors, agents, representatives, and/or employees against all claims, demands, actions, lawsuits, costs, damages and expenses, including attorneys' fees, judgments, fines and amounts arising from any willful act, omission, error, recklessness or negligence of FARMINGDALE, its Board of Education, Board members, officers, directors, representatives, and/or employees in connection with the performance of services pursuant to this Agreement. The obligations pursuant to this provision shall survive the termination of this Agreement.

### Supplemental Agreement between the

### West Islip Union Free School District

#### and

Supplemental Agreement dated this 1st day of January 30, 2023 between the West Islip Union Free School District (the "District"), located at 100 Sherman Avenue, West Islip, New York and PPT Therapies of Western Suffolk, PT, OT, SLP, LLP the ("Contractor") located at 77 Veterans Memorial Highway, Suite 5, Commack, New York 11725-3410.

WHEREAS, the District and Contractor have entered into a contract or other written agreement (hereinafter the "Agreement") whereby the Contractor may receive Student Data or Teacher or Principal Data, as those terms are defined in Education Law §2-d and 8 NYCRR 121.1; and

WHEREAS, the District and Contractor wish to enter into an agreement in order to comply with Education Law §2-d and 8 NYCRR Part 121 (hereinafter "Supplemental Agreement").

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises below, the District and Contractor agree as follows:

- 1. <u>Defined Terms</u>: Unless otherwise indicated below or elsewhere in this Supplemental Agreement, all capitalized terms shall have the meanings provided in Education Law §2-d and Section 121.1 of the Regulations of the Commissioner of Education (hereinafter "Regulations").
  - a. "Educational Agency" shall generally have the same meaning as the term Educational Agency at Education Law §2-d(1)(c) and Section 121.1(f), and in reference to the party to this Agreement shall mean the West Islip Union Free School District

"Third Party Contractor" shall mean any person or entity, other than an Educational Agency, that receives Student Data or Teacher or Principal Data from an Educational Agency pursuant to a contract or other written agreement for purposes of providing services to such Educational Agency, including but not limited to data management or storage services, conducting studies for or on behalf of such Educational Agency, or audit or evaluation of publicly funded programs. With reference to this agreement, "Third Party Contractor" shall be synonymous with "Contractor" and shall also include any and all subcontractors, persons or entities with whom the Contractor shares Student Data and/or Principal or Teacher Data pursuant to a contract or other written agreement for purposes of providing services to such Educational Agency, including but not limited to data management or storage services, conducting studies for or on behalf of such Educational Agency, or audit or evaluation of publicly funded programs, and in reference to the party to this Agreement shall mean PPT Therapies of Western Suffolk, PT, OT, SLP, LLP.

- b. "Student" means any person attending or seeking to enroll in an Educational Agency.
- c. "Student Data" means Personally Identifiable Information of a "Student."

- d. "Eligible Student" means a Student who is eighteen years or older.
- e. "Parent" means a parent, legal guardian, or personal in parental relation to a Student.
- f. "Building Principal" or "Principal" means a building principal subject to annual performance evaluation review under Education Law §3012-c.
- g. "Classroom Teacher" or "Teacher" means a teacher subject to annual performance evaluation review under Education Law §3012-c.
- h. "Teacher or Principal Data" means Personally Identifiable Information from the records of an Educational Agency relating to the annual professional performance reviews of classroom teachers or principals that is confidential and not subject to release under the provisions of Education Law §3012-c.
- i. "Personally Identifiable Information" shall have the following meanings:
  - i. As applied to Student Data, shall mean Personally Identifiable Information as defined in 34 CFR 99.3 implementing the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA)
  - ii. As applied to Teacher or Principal Data, shall mean Personally Identifiable Information as that term is defined in Education Law §3012-c.
- 2. The District has developed the Parents Bill of Rights for Data Privacy and Security, the terms of which are applicable to the Agreement between the District and Contractor and are incorporated into this Supplemental Agreement. The Parents Bill of Rights for Data Privacy and Security states:
  - a. A student's personally identifiable information cannot be sold or released for any commercial purposes.
  - b. Parents have the right to inspect and review the complete contents of their child's education record maintained by the West Islip Union Free School District.
  - c. State and federal laws protect the confidentiality of personally identifiable information. Safeguards associated with industry standards and best practices, including but not limited to, encryption, firewalls, and password protection, must be in place when data is stored or transferred.

- f. "Supplemental information" for each contract into which the District enters with a third party who receives student data or teacher or principal data shall:
  - state the exclusive purposes for which the student data or teacher or principal data will be used;
  - ii. specify how the third party contractor will ensure that the subcontractors, persons or entities that the third party contractor will share the student data or teacher or principal data with, if any, will abide by data protection and security requirements;
  - iii. stipulate when the agreement expires and what will happen to the student data or teacher or principal data upon expiration of the agreement;
  - iv. include if and how a parent, student, eligible student, teacher or principal may challenge the accuracy of the student data or teacher or principal data that is collected; and
  - v. state where the student data or teacher or principal data will be stored and the security protections taken to ensure such data will be protected.

This Bill of Rights is subject to change based on regulations of the Commissioner of Education and the New York State Education Department's Chief Privacy Officer, as well as emerging guidance documents.

- 3. As required by Education Law §2-d(3)(c) and Section 121.3 of the Regulations, the District has developed the following "supplemental information" for the Agreement with the Contractor:
  - a. Student Data and/or Teacher or Principal Data which the Contractor comes into possession as part of its Agreement with the District shall be used for the following

exclusive purpose(s): to provide tutorial services in accordance with the underlying agreement.

- b. The Contractor will ensure that any and all subcontractors, persons or entities that the Contractor may share the Student Data and/or Principal or Teacher Data with will abide by the terms of the Agreement, this Supplemental Agreement, and the data protection and security requirements set forth in Education Law §2-d and Part 121 of the Regulations.
- c. The duration of this agreement coincides with the duration of the parties' underlying Agreement, which is currently set to expire on June 30, 2023. When the Agreement between the District and the Contractor expires or terminates, the Contractor shall return to the District all remaining Student Data and/or Principal or Teacher Data or, if agreed to by the District, destroy the remaining Student Data and/or Principal or Teacher Data that the Contractor still maintains in any form.
- d. Any challenges concerning the accuracy of Student Data and/or Principal Data shall be handled directly between the District and the Parent, Student, Eligible Student, Teacher or Principal. The Contractor agrees to abide by the outcome of such challenges and make any corrections and/or changes to the applicable Student Data and/or Principal or Teacher Data as determined by the District." or "The Contractor and District agree to notify the other party of any challenge to the accuracy of Student Data and/or Principal Data. The District and Contractor agree that the party who is responsible for the development of the Student Data and/or Principal Data shall make the final determination with regard to any corrections and/or changes to the applicable Student Data and/or Principal or Teacher Data.
- e. The District and the Contractor hereby agree that the Student Data and/or Principal or Teacher Data shall be stored in the following manner: [Insert (i) a description of where Student Data and/or Principal or Teacher Data will be stored, described in a manner to protect data security, (ii) a description of the security protections taken to ensure Student Data and/or Principal or Teacher Data will be protected and data security and privacy risks are mitigated; and (iii) a description of how the Student Data and/or Principal or Teacher Data will be protected using encryption while in motion and at rest.]
  - website to document service provision and progress updates. Printed copies will be provided to the District upon request. PPT will maintain a copy of record in a secured file cabinet on our premises. PPT will only use student data to document activities and progress for related service sessions, for billing of related service sessions, for documenting progress over the course of the school year (i.e. quarterly progress marks, annual reviews) and evaluations. Parents, students, teachers or principal who seek to challenge the accuracy of PII (District Data) will do so by contracting the District. If a correction to data is deemed necessary, the District will notify PPT. PPT agrees to facilitate such corrections with 21 calendar days of receiving the District's written request. PII (District Data) received by a Subcontractor will be received, assessed and used only to perform the Subcontractors' services pursuant to the Service Agreement with the District. The Subcontractor will only share PII with entities or person authorized in the Service Agreement. The Subcontractor is contracted with PPT and is

required to adhere to, at a minimum, materially similar data protection obligations imposed on PPT by state and federal laws and regulations, and the Service Agreement. Digital District Data is only stored on the Frontline Education website. Printed copies are maintained at the PPT office in Commack, NY. Frontline Education provides a secure website for IEP access, entering and maintaining session notes, and a document repository for other reports. PPT maintains a paper file for students in a locked file cabinet in our offices. PPT will conduct periodic risk assessments and remediate any identified security vulnerabilities in a timely manner. Any printed Student records are maintained at least 1 year after the student turns 21 years old and are stored in a secured/locked file cabinet on PPT premises. Printed copies are shredded in accordance with HIPAA guidelines.

- f. The parties hereby incorporate by reference the Data Privacy and Security Plan and Data Privacy Plan attached hereto as Appendix E.
- 4. As required by Education Law §2-d(5)(e), the Contractor hereby agrees that any officers or employees of the Contractor, including any subcontractors or assignees, who have access to Student Data or Teacher or Principal Data will have or will receive training on the Federal and New York State laws governing confidentiality of Student Data and/or Principal or Teacher Data prior to receiving access.
- 5. As required by Education Law §2-d(5)(f), the Contractor hereby agrees that it shall:
  - a. Limit internal access to education records to those individuals that are determined to have legitimate educational interests;
  - b. Not use the educational records for any other purposes than those explicitly authorized in the Agreement or this Supplemental Agreement;
  - c. Except for authorized representatives of the Contractor to the extent they are carrying out the Agreement or this Supplemental Agreement, not disclose any Personally Identifiable Information to any other party:
    - i. Without the prior written consent of the Parent or Eligible Student; or
    - ii. Unless required by statute or court order and the party provides a notice of the disclosure to the State Education Department, District Board of Education, or institution that provided the information no later than the time the information is disclosed, unless providing notice of the disclosure is expressly prohibited by the statute or court order.
  - d. maintain reasonable administrative, technical and physical safeguards to protect the security, confidentiality and integrity of personally identifiable student information in its custody;
- 6. Breach and unauthorized release of Personally Identifiable Information:
  - a. In accordance with Education Law §2-d(6) and Section 121.11 of the Regulations, the Contractor shall be required to notify the District of any breach of security resulting

in an unauthorized release of Student Data and/or Principal or Teacher Data by the Contractor or its subcontractors or assignees in violation of applicable state or federal law, the Parents Bill of Rights for Student Data Privacy and Security, the data privacy and security policies of the District and/or binding contractual obligations relating to data privacy and security, in the most expedient way possible and without unreasonable delay. The District shall, upon notification by the Contractor, be required to report to the Chief Privacy Officer, who is appointed by the State Education Department, any such breach of security and unauthorized release of such data.

- In the case of an unauthorized release of Student Data, the District shall notify the b. Parent or Eligible Student of the unauthorized release of Student Data that includes Personally Identifiable Information from the student records of such Student in the most expedient way possible and without unreasonable delay. In the case of an unauthorized release of Teacher or Principal Data, the District shall notify each affected Teacher or Principal of the unauthorized release of data that includes Personally Identifiable Information from the Teacher or Principal's annual professional performance review in the most expedient way possible and without unreasonable delay.
- In the case of notification to a Parent, Eligible Student, Teacher or Principal due C. to the unauthorized release of student data by the Contractor, or its subcontractors or assignees, the Contractor shall promptly reimburse the educational agency for the full cost of such notification, as required by Education Law §2-d(6)(c).

#### 7. Miscellaneous:

- The District and Contractor agree that if applicable laws change and/or if the Commissioner of Education implements Regulations which affects the obligations of the parties herein, this Agreement shall be deemed to incorporate such changes as necessary in order for the District and the Contractor to operate in compliance with the amendment or modified requirements under the applicable laws or regulations.
- Any ambiguity in this Agreement shall be resolved in favor of a meaning that permits the District to comply with the applicable laws or regulations.
- Nothing express or implied in this Agreement is intended to confer upon any person other than the District, Contractor and their respective successors and assigns any rights, remedies, obligations or liabilities.
