 Dr. Patrick Kiley-Rendon is leading the charge to re-designing our website.
- Instruction ~ further development of our Profile of a Graduate work to define attributes in all subject areas; evaluate grading practices; refining course offerings; develop mastery learning.
- Facilities ~ exceeding the recommended security standards ensuring a safe and secure learning environment for all students and staff; rethinking instructional spaces that support 21st century learning.
- Technology ~ develop a District statement on Artificial Intelligence; implement NYS Computer Science and Digital Fluency Standards; technology competencies across all grade levels.

SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE LEASE AGREEMENT

This Amendment is made this _____ day of _______, 2024, by and between the Board of Education, West Islip Union Free School District, Town of Islip, Suffolk County, New York, a corporation existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of New York, having its principal office at 100 Sherman Avenue, West Islip, Suffolk County, New York 11795 (hereinafter referred to as the "DISTRICT"), and the Divine Rhythms Dance Inc., a corporation existing under the laws of the State of New York having its principal office at 15 Cooper Street..

Babylon, New York 11702, hereinafter referred to as "DIVINE RHYTHMS."

WHEREAS, the DISTRICT and DIVINE RHYTHMS entered into a lease agreement, dated June 20, 2018, annexed hereto and incorporated herein, for certain areas within the Westbrook Elementary School (the "Lease Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the DISTRICT and DIVINE RHYTHMS entered into an amendment to the lease agreement dated October 23, 2018 providing for modifications to said Lease Agreement (the "First Amendment"); and

WHEREAS, the DISTRICT and DIVINE RHYTHMS have agreed to amend the Lease Agreement to include the terms and conditions as more fully set forth herein (the "Second Amendment"); and

WHEREAS, the DISTRICT has determined and by approval of this Agreement does hereby declare that the Premises as set forth in the Lease Agreement is not currently needed for school district purposes and that an amendment of the Lease Agreement is in the best interests of the DISTRICT.

NOW, THEREFORE, the DISTRICT and DIVINE RHYTHMS hereby agree as follows:

1. Effective for the 2024-2025 school year, September 1, 2024 through June 30, 2028, the first "WHEREAS" clause of the Lease Agreement is hereby amended and restated as follows:

WHEREAS, the DISTRICT has agreed to lease to DIVINE RHYTHMS the cafeteria, stage, kitchen, two music rooms adjacent to the kitchen, principal's office, main office, nurse's office, MST lab, greenhouse, music room 100, music room, art room, music room 2, art room 101, classroom 102, classroom 103, classroom 104, classroom 105, classroom 106, classroom 109, copy room and storage room at the Westbrook Elementary School, located at 350 Higbie Lane, West Islip, NY 11795 (the "Building");

2. Paragraph 2 of the Lease Agreement, entitled, "DEMISED PREMISES" is hereby amended and restated as follows:

Subject to the terms set forth in this agreement (hereinafter. the "Lease"), the DISTRICT hereby leases to DIVINE RHYTHMS, and DIVINE RHYTHMS hereby leases from the DISTRICT, the cafeteria, stage, kitchen, two music rooms adjacent to the kitchen, principal's office, main office, nurse's office, MST lab, greenhouse, music room 100, music room, art room, music room 2, art room 101, classroom 102, classroom 103, classroom 105, classroom 106, classroom 109, copy room and storage room in the Building (hereinafter, the "Premises" or "Demised Premises") as set forth in detail in the floor plan attached as Exhibit "A." The parties stipulate that the Premises consist of 16,929 square feet.

- 3. Paragraph 4 of the Lease Agreement, entitled, "Rent" is hereby amended and restated as follows:
 - h. Year Eight (September 1, 2024 to June 30, 2025): a ten-month Base Rent of \$148,216.92 which shall consist of 10 monthly Base Rent payments in the amount of \$14,821.69 plus Additional Rent for sprinkler installation over a ten-month period in the amount of \$14,650.83 which shall consist of 10 monthly Additional Rent payment in the amount of \$1,465.08. The total ten-month Base Rent and Additional Rent combined is \$162,867.76, which consists of 10 monthly payments of \$16,286.78.
 - i. Year Nine (July 1, 2025 to June 30, 2026): an annual Base Rent of \$183,196.12, which shall consist of 12 monthly Base Rent

payments in the annual amount of \$15,266.34 plus Additional Rent for sprinkler installation annually in the amount of \$17,581.00 which shall consist of 12 monthly Additional Rent payment in the amount of \$1,465.08. The total annual Base Rent and Additional Rent combined is \$200,777.12, which consists of 12 monthly payments of \$16,731.43.

- j. Year Ten (July 1, 2026 to June 30, 2027): an annual Base Rent of \$188,692.00 which shall consist of 12 monthly Base Rent payments in the amount of \$15,724.33, plus Additional Rent for sprinkler installation annually in the amount of \$17,581.00 which shall consist of 12 monthly Additional Rent payment in the amount of \$1,465.08. The total annual Base Rent and Additional Rent combined is \$206,273.00 which consist of 12 monthly payments of \$17,189.42.
- 3. In the event that the DISTRICT and DIVINE RHYTHMS determine to relet classroom 104 and/or classroom 108 back to DIVINE RHYTHMS at any time during the term of the Lease Agreement, the parties shall enter into successor amendment whereby the lease shall be readjusted based upon the original calculations set forth in the original Lease Agreement.

IT IS UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED that the covenants contained in this Amendment to the Lease shall be binding upon the parties hereto and upon their respective successors.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have caused this instrument to be signed and executed by their fully appointed officers.
